**FairPoint Completes Network Improvements in Guilford,
Sangerville and Abbot, Maine**

New Equipment Upgrades Broadband Service in the Communities

PORTLAND, Maine (October 6, 2015) - FairPoint Communications has installed new technology in the towns of Guilford, Sangerville and Abbot, Maine bringing greater broadband speed to customers served by these facilities. The new equipment means that FairPoint has upgraded service to more than 1330 additional homes and businesses in the three towns.

Since April 2008, FairPoint has invested more than \$700 million in its communications infrastructure and technology to reach new customers, upgrade its network and expand broadband in northern New England, including building thousands of miles of new fiber across the region, offering customers a better, faster way to communicate.

"Broadband access opens doors to the world for the residents and businesses in Maine and is fundamental to the state's future economic growth," said Mike Reed, FairPoint's Maine state president. "We are pleased to announce we have upgraded the availability of high-speed Internet to more homes and businesses in Guilford, Sangerville and Abbot."

This project will provide broadband service with speeds up to 15Mbps available in the communities. Customers may qualify for different speeds based upon their distance from the central office that serves their specific location. Building the most robust and versatile network across the region is crucial to handle the increasing demands for bandwidth, Reed said.

"FairPoint's network - with nearly 17,000 miles of fiber in northern New England - is the largest in the region," said Jeff Nevins, FairPoint's Director of Community Broadband Development. "This project will help meet the growing demand for bandwidth and provide faster speeds for many people in the three communities."

Abbot: Back, Davidson, Gales, Hitchin Post Lane, Main, Leeman, Monson Junction Lane and Old Mill.

Sangerville: Burrough, Church, Craig Lane, Douty Hill, Haley Court, High, Hunnewell Avenue, Main, Maple, McPhetres, Mill, N. Dexter, Oakes Manor, Pleasant Avenue, Pumphouse, School, Town Hall Avenue and Thomas.
